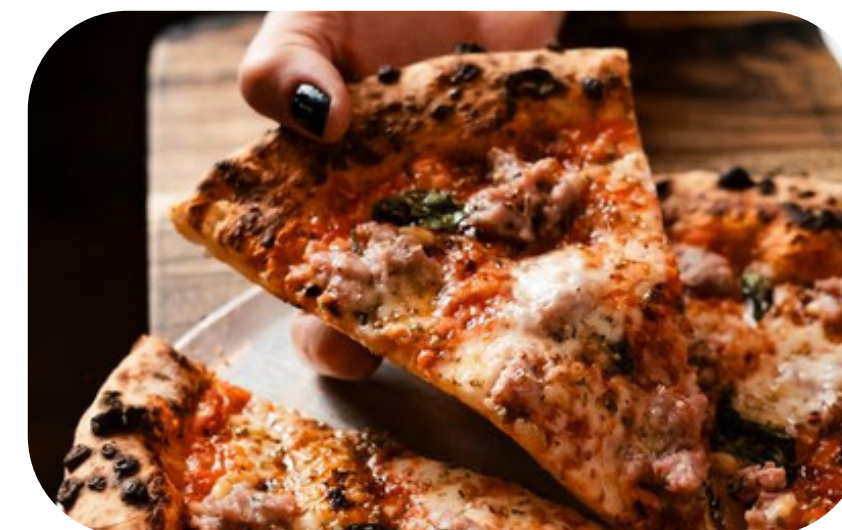

WHAT TO EXPECT

WOLLONGONG IS HOME TO BEACH BREAK AND POINT BREAKS THAT WORK IN A VARIETY OF CONDITIONS. THE MAIN BASE FOR THE EVENT WILL BE WOONONA BEACH, HOWEVER THE EVENT IS MOBILE WITH NUMEROUS OPTIONS AVAILABLE WITHIN A CLOSE PROXIMITY INCLUDING STANWELL PARK, SCARBOROUGH, AUSTINMER, THIRROUL, MACAULEYS, SANDON POINT, BULLI, BELAMBI POINT, CORRIMAL, TOWRADGI, FAIRY MEADOW, NORTH WOLLONGONG, CITY BEACH AND PORT KEMBLA BEACHES. ALL EVENT OPTIONS OFFER A VARIETY OF WAVE OPTIONS THAT WORK IN A VARIETY OF CONDITIONS. EXPECT WAVES IN THE 2-4 FOOT RANGE. EXPECT WATER TEMPS APPROX. 19 - 21C, 2MM SPRINGSUITS ARE RECOMMENDED, BUT STEAMERS ARE ALSO ADVISED.

THE NORTHERN END OF THE WOLLONGONG STRETCH GENERALLY PICKS UP MORE SWELL IN COMPARISON TO CITY BEACH OR OTHER LOCATIONS AROUND THE CITY.

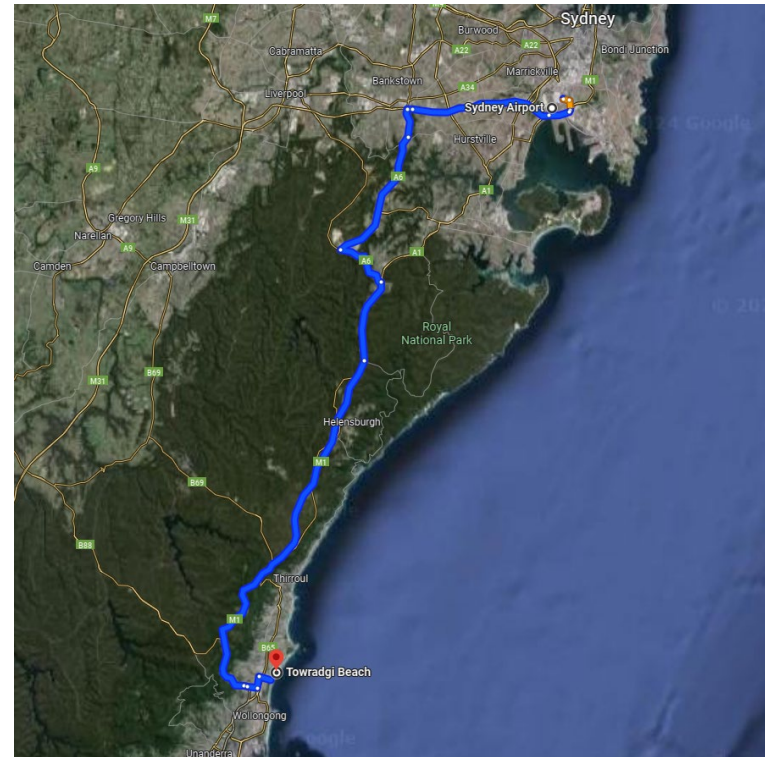
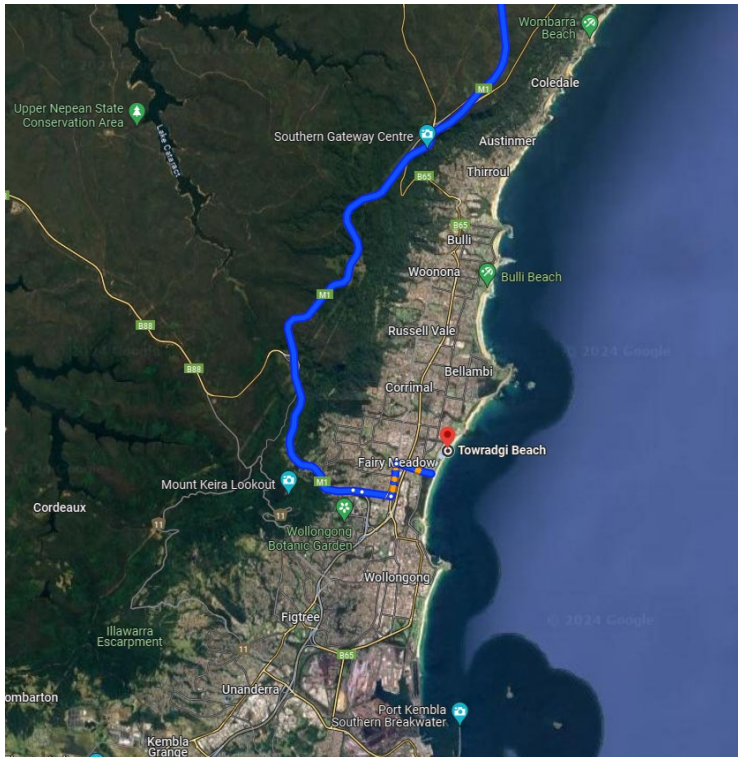

EVENT FORMAT & PRIORITY INFO

THE 2025 AUSTRALIAN JUNIOR SURFING TITLES WILL UTILISE A NEW FORMAT FROM PREVIOUS YEARS WITH EVENT FORMATS DESIGNED BY SURFING AUSTRALIA. THIS YEARS FORMAT REWARDS THE CHAMPIONS FROM EACH STATE TITLE WITH A SEEDED START IN THE NATIONAL TITLE AS WELL AS HONOURING THE NATIONAL ROLLING SEEDING WHICH WAS DEVELOPED EARLIER THIS YEAR.

FOR EXAMPLE NSW WERE THE CHAMPION STATE AT THE 2024 AUSTRALIAN JUNIOR SURFING TITLES, THE 2024 STATE CHAMPION FROM NSW IS SEED 1 IN THE NATIONAL TITLES AND HAS A SEEDED START IN ROUND 3.

- 50% PROGRESSION THROUGHOUT WITH SECOND CHANCE FORMATS
- SURFER-ON-SURFER HEATS FROM SEMI-FINALS ONWARDS
